## ***Jail Alternative STATEMENT OF SERVICES***

The Richland County Community Alternative Center is a unique and comprehensive jail sentencing option to house male and female offenders (housed and programmed separately) from adult Common Pleas Courts, Municipal Courts, and Mayor's Courts in the Ohio and surrounding states.

The program, in operation since 2005, has proven success in managing jail alternative sentencing. The program was developed under the direction of the Richland County Community Corrections Board and the Richland County Adult Courts. It is a **cost effective** means of reducing the normal County/City jail population and at little or no cost to the Courts as **offenders are responsible for paying the \$40 per diem.**

**A finalized report will be faxed/mailed to Courts, Attorney, and/or Probation Officer upon offender's completion of program.**

**The services provided for jail time served at a per diem cost of \$40:**

- **Housing for 24/7 (all bedding and linen supplies provided) for male and female offenders (each housed on separate floors of the facility with no contact).**
- **Daily meals (3)/ Vending Available**
- **Laundry services**
- **Alcohol test on all returns to the facility; and drug testing routinely**
- **Library services**
- **Voluntary religious programming**
- **Video security of all programming areas**
- **Visitation**
- **Work release privileges (if authorized by the Court); otherwise, offenders can be placed on “lock-down” status which means they can not leave the facility unless accompanied by administrative of security staff**
- **24/7 security personnel for internal control of offenders**
- **Random room searches and pat-downs of all residents**
- **Case Managers assigned to monitor offender work site checks, program attendance, and authorized releases from the facility**
