The Richland County Community Alternative Center provides gender-specific residential placement and ODADAS certified treatment programming for Adult Court offenders. The program is designed as a **jail diversion, treatment, and sentencing option** for the Ohio Municipal and Common Pleas Court system.

**Cost Effective Per Diem Cost of \$50 includes:**

**(30-60-90+ day Programs)**

- **ODADAS certified substance abuse treatment:** All services are gender specific; no programming component is co-ed.
- **Case management** to provide referral for specific needs including medical care, post release continued substance abuse counseling/dual diagnosis services, ongoing collaboration with probation officers/criminal justice representative.
- **Housing:** Males and females are housed on separate units and have no interaction with each other in treatment or residential programming.
- **Three meals daily.**
- **Laundry Services.**
- **Alcohol and drug testing**
- **Searches:** Random room searches and pat-downs of residents.
- **24/7 security personnel** for internal control. Video security of all programming areas
- **Drug/Alcohol Assessments (\$60)**
